Garry will volunteer full-time in the BSPCA marketing and development office as a communications specialist from September 2009 to August 2010.

Garry will be based out of the Concord, NH, office and travel periodically to BSPCA’s Montpelier, VT, office.

A former resident of Moultonborough, Garry completed his Bachelor of Arts in Political Science, with a focus on International Relations, at the University of New Hampshire in 2008. Upon graduation, he volunteered for AmeriCorps and worked as a legal assistant at the Massachusetts Legal Aid for Self Sufficiency Program. At BSPCA, Garry will report on the plans and accomplishments of Community Health Centers in NH and VT as they implement measures to ensure greater access to primary health care.
